Reminders for NetSetGo Coaches, Managers and Parents

Coaches and Managers please ensure you have read Bankstown City's Handbook, so that you are familiar with the Net Set Go rules.

A few points to note for Coaches, Managers and Parents:

- NetSetGo netball on a Saturday is a training and teaching time for young netballers. It is important that coaches and parents don't lose sight of this each week at the game.
- Each week for the 5, 6 & 7's only ONE umpire is required for the Net Set Go game and ideally should be the Coach of the nominated team in the fixture book, so the coach/umpire can help position the players on court and the children are only listening to ONE voice on court, not many from the sideline.
- The umpire should use simple language and explain her/his decisions and be encouraging to both teams particularly in the setting up of penalties and throw ins.
- No parent should be on the court or moving up and down the sideline with the game shouting instructions. This is very confusing to the children. Let the umpire and coach do her/his job.

- Players should have equal time on the court during the course of a game. Also, players should experience each position (ie. rotating players). By the end of week 14, all players should have had the opportunity to play every position a number of times - after all NetSetGo is a learning experience. There is a sheet in the Handbook to keep track of this.
- Parents should not stand close to the sidelines of the court, give the players room to run off the court to retrieve a ball if necessary, stand well back from the line.
 DO NOT on the goal post (baseline) lines.
- No coaching is allowed from the baseline in any netball age group.
- No jewellery is to be worn at all taping jewellery is not allowed, if the jewellery can't be removed then the player can't play.
